I work as a Youth worker in the Municipality of Kruševac in Youth office and in charge of managing the programs and activities at Youth Club of Municipality of Kruševac.

What makes your job exciting?

Unpredictability, level of energy and the amount of ideas young people that surround me on everyday basis makes my job even more than exciting.

What are your dreams as a youth worker?

My most memorable experience was the training course for gaining the youth worker status. It changed my views and made me understand my core values. As a part of the training, I worked with a group of young people from my municipality. Today, 7 years later, all of the 25 young people are involved in some shape, way of form in working with young people and making their communicates a better place for youth.
